African Community Association (ACA) announces the availability of book scholarships, to be awarded for Academic Excellence.

Decision about the scholarships will be announced during the second week of September when all applicants will be notified of the status of their application. Successful applicants will be invited to the award ceremonies as special guests of the ACA. The award ceremonies will be held on September 20, 2025, at the Hilton Garden Inn, 8971 Wilcox Dr., Twinsburg, OH 44087 in conjunction with the *African Community Association (ACA) Annual Scholarship Dinner*.

## **Eligibility for the Awards:**

The ACA scholarships are open to students who are African nationals or born to parent(s) who are African nationals. Immediate ACA family members are not eligible to apply. Candidates must be full time students pursuing baccalaureate or graduate degrees at northeast Ohio colleges and universities. Applicants who are pursuing their education outside of northeast Ohio must be residents of northeast Ohio in the semester the award is granted. Those who have won the award within the past 12 months are not eligible.

## **Requirements for the Awards:**

- 1. The applicants must:
  - have successfully completed their freshman requirements (or one semester of graduate work),
  - have earned at least a cumulative grade point average of 3.00 on a 4.00-point scale,
  - be registered for the semester in which the award is granted, and
  - submit a copy of their most current academic transcripts.
- 2. Applications for the awards must be made on the standard application form. Fill out the form completely and save on your computer. Then send it with the PDF copies of required documents (transcripts, extracurricular activities, etc.) to the address below.
- 3. The deadline for the applications is September 6, 2025.

**Note**: The ACA scholarships are awarded to qualifying applicants who have demonstrated superior academic record (3.00 g.p.a. or better) with comparable civic and leadership qualities. Considerations are also given to applicants with special financial needs. Applicants may use their work schedule and pay stubs (i.e., proof of self-supporting, or working to defray academic costs) to demonstrate evidence of financial needs.
